REFLECTION: Acts 12.1-11; Psalm - Choir; 2 Timothy 4.6-8, 17-18; John 21.15-22

Today we celebrate the two great missionaries – St Peter and St Paul, both of whom were martyred for their faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus asks Peter if he loves him. When an affirmative answer is given (three times, no less) Jesus commands Peter to look after his sheep. This command, though primarily to Peter as an example of episcopal/ordained ministry, can be applied to us all: those of us who say we love Jesus should provide pastoral care – a listening ear and a loving heart – to those around us.

Pray that our churches will be recognised as places where God's care can be experienced.
