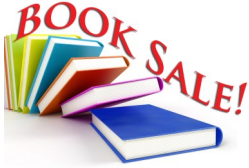

**REFLECTION:** Genesis 37.1-4, 12-28; Psalm 105.1-6, 16-22; Rom.10.4-15; Matt. 14.22-36

Jesus calls us out of the boat. Recently I heard a sermon preached by the Families' Worker, Elizabeth, in my home parish. In her sermon, she reflected on the nature of the Church, and pointed to the roof, which bears resemblance to an upturned ship. She asked us to picture ourselves on the ship, and what we were doing there: are we on holidays, enjoying ourselves and the safety the ship provides? Are we in the lower cabins, uncertain of the course set out before us over the clamour of our circumstance? Or are we in the engine room, working to ensure we get to our destination safely?

She said that sometimes Jesus calls us to step out in faith. Jesus calls us out of the boat, and when we fail to hold all faith, he is there, hand outstretched, to remind us of his strength to hold us above the waters.

*Pray that Jesus will lead us where our trust is without borders, that we will walk upon the waters wherever he will call us.*
