

Christmas Craft

Nativity Finger Puppets

After hearing the Christmas story, it would be great to offer the children something to enable them to retell it to themselves or other family members.

See below for templates

Materials:

- 1 sheet of A4 card per child with the photocopied finger puppets: Angel, Mary, Joseph, Shepherd, Magi.
- scissors, glue
- coloured pencils, felt pens
- · craft materials for decorating



What to do:


- Colour in the figures.
- Cut out the black holes fingers go in there to make legs.
- You can offer glitter or jewels made from scrunched-up chocolate wrappers for the Magi, cotton wool for a lamb for the shepherd, glitter for the angel, pipe cleaner for the crook, a piece of cord for Joseph's waist, lace for Mary's head-dress...

This would be a great item to go in a Take-Home Bag or Booklet.

Below: Nativity Finger Puppet templates:


Top row (*left to right:*) Wise man, angel, Joseph **Second row** (*left to right*): Mary, shepherd.

Try them out first: enlarge if the holes are not quite big enough for the children's fingers.
